What **can** I bring into Emirates Stadium?



Small compact cameras
(Must be able to fit in a pocket)



Small fold up umbrellas



Empty solid containers or flasks



Empty clear plastic bottles (500ml or less)



Non-offensive flags or banners
(2m x 1m or less)
(No sticks or poles and must meet fire regulations)



Smaller than A4 only
(21cm x 29.7cm)
No large bags or suitcases



Crutches or walking aids

What **can't** I bring into Emirates Stadium?



Alcohol



Canned drinks



Drinking glasses



Glass bottles



Glass vessels
(e.g. Perfume)



Plastic bottles in excess of 500ml



Air horns



Baby buggies or prams



Video recording equipment



Large lens cameras



Poles or sticks
(Including Selfie-sticks)



Dangerous or hazardous items



Knives or weapons



Large bags or suitcases
(Including cabin bags) laptop bags and rucksacks



Umbrellas
(Except small fold-up umbrellas)



Fireworks or flares



Smoke or gas canisters



Laser pens



Tools



Musical instruments



Emirates Stadium is a no smoking stadium, this includes the use of electronic cigarettes and vaporisers



In line with Premier League, FA, and EFL guidance to all clubs, flags, banners or other symbols and materials that display content considered discriminatory, offensive, or politically motivated remain prohibited from Emirates Stadium.

Flags or banners larger than 2m x 1m are also prohibited.

And any article that might be used as a weapon and/or compromise public safety.
Any person in possession of such items may be refused entry to or ejected from the Ground.
